Frances Leggat was born in Winnipeg, Manitoba January 11, 1935, to Dutch parents Johannes and Cornelia Vergonet. She passed away peacefully in Duncan May 13, 2019. Survived by sisters Trudy and Joan, predeceased by siblings Margaret, Corey, Lyn, Anne, and brother John.
