Passed away peacefully in 2014 at Cowichan District Hospital. Margaret was born in 1921 at King's Daughters Hospital (now Cairnsmore Place), Duncan. She attended Duncan Elementary School and Duncan High School. After graduation, she attended Sprott-Shaw College in Victoria. In December of 1941, she met Donald Filion, a soldier in the North Shore Regiment based in New Brunswick whose unit was based temporarily in Victoria. They were married in May 1942. Don was killed on September 17, 1944 in France. During the war years and after, Margaret worked as a legal secretary to various lawyers in Duncan. In later years, she assisted David Williams in preparing his manuscripts for the publication of his books. Margaret was predeceased by her brother Lewis and her sister Nairn (Callewaert). Surviving family members are sisters Doreen (Wilkinson) and Glenys (Lister).
