She then turned her passion for flower arranging into her next career, working many years at the Floral Art Shop until her retirement. She continued doing it for friends for many years after. Sheila was involved with many clubs over the years most recently the I.O.D.E., Probus and the Hospital Auxiliary. She was also an usher at the Cowichan Theatre and a member of the St. Peters Anglican Church Altar Guild.
